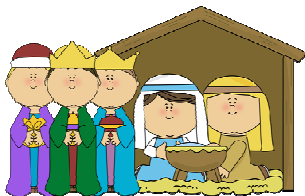

Helen A.

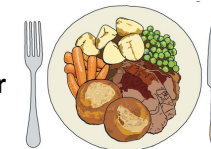
