DIOCESAN INTERCESSIONS

On **Saturday 19th January** St George's Church Worthing will be prayed for in Chichester Cathedral at the 12 noon Holy Communion service and again at 5.30pm (possibly Sung Evensong). The services are open to any one to attend but if you would like to take advantage of the complimentary tea in the Cloisters Café at 4.30pm please let Helen in the church office know so that you can be booked in.

ST GEORGE'S MISSION FUND RECIPIENTS

Each year our Church financially supports Christian Missions whose work meets the needs of people and makes known the message of God's love. The main Mission recipients are CPAS (UK), Operation Mobilisation (world-wide), Tear Fund (world-wide), Katherine Marrow (Honduras). In addition, from the 2018 Mission Fund allocation we have made one-off donations to the Bible Society working in UK and overseas, to Lama Ministries working with street children in Philippines and to CBM - a Christian charity working overseas with disabled children and adults. CBM started out in 1920s as the 'Christian Blind Mission', seeking to improve eyesight problems. It now covers parts of Africa, Asia, Middle East & Latin America. Over 10 million cataract operations have been performed, restoring sight. Treatments offered now includes ear, nose, throat & other health problems. In many countries those with disabilities are often ignored, yet CBM works to improve their lives and make known the gospel good news.
