REDEVELOPMENT UPDATE

We have at last been able to make an application to the Diocese for our redevelopment. It was considered by them on 14th February. We have their decision, which is to defer to a later date, as they require more information from us. The good news is, they approve of, and support, nearly all our proposals. They want us to justify our choice of flooring (Karndean) and our choice of chair (sample in church) as they prefer both to be wood. We are working on this with our architect and will reapply as soon as possible.
