CPAS - Strives for Healthy Churches

CPAS stands for 'Church Pastoral Aid Society', a UK Christian Mission with a history since 1836. Its aims are to encourage and support UK churches to be Christ centred, Bible based and Mission focused. St George's shares those same important aims and that's why we give regular financial support from our Missions Fund to CPAS. Last summer over 3,000 children and young people across the UK enjoyed CPAS holidays with a mixture of fun and faith - learning what life with Jesus can mean. On the staff of CPAS for co-ordinating some of these holidays is Rev Paul Peterson, who will be speaking at our 19th May Missions service, on the work of CPAS. Training people in leadership skills is an important focus by CPAS for leaders to be (i) clear about their calling, (ii) grow in Christ-like character, (iii) competent to lead in times of change. From October 2017 to July 2018 we ran a CPAS 'Growing Leaders' course, for 12 of our church members, to explore and apply these principles to their own faith and calling. *Missions Team Report*

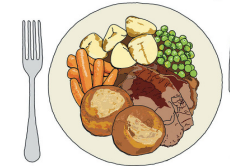
